**VENDORS SOUGHT FOR 2009 WABASH FARMER'S MARKET**

WABASH, Ind. – For those interested in selling fresh fruits, vegetables or plants in the Wabash Farmer's Market – held every Saturday between June 6 and October 17 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. – applications are now being accepted.

The Farmer's Market is hosted by Wabash Marketplace, Inc; however, the location has remained in the Honeywell Center parking lot, 275 W. Market St. in downtown Wabash.

Vendors will be expected to set-up their own tables and chairs, and to dispose of all trash at the end of the day. Additionally, a \$40 fee will be charged for participating in the full season or \$20 for a half season after August 17. All vendors will be required to meet State, Local, and USDA Health Department Codes.
